

TWO SEASONS 2007 VOLLEYBALL RULES

GENERAL RULES

1. Roster: all rosters will be limited to 15 individuals. The final roster will be due at the start of your 3rd. game.
2. Entry fee will be \$175.00 April 21st is the Deadline. No exceptions!! Schedules can be picked up April 28, 2007. Or you can get schedules on the web at www.two-seasons-bowl.com. Leagues start Week of May 1st.
3. A match will consist of 3 games. Both wins and losses will be recorded on team standings by the team captains. Results will be posted on the web page. It is the responsibility of the team to report scores.
4. A team on the court will consist of 6 players, 3 males and 3 females. A minimum of 4 players may be used to play a game. If there is a player shortage, keep in mind that the men can not outnumber women by more than 1. Example: 4 men and 2 women or 3 men and 1 woman.
5. The 1st. team to score 15 points and wins by 2 points wins the game. If the 3rd. game is not done within the 60 minute time limit, the game will end with the score being what it is at the end of the 60 minutes. In the case of a tie, there will be a 1 point tie breaker.
6. Since there will be no official it will be up to each team captain to settle disputes. If no decision can be honestly made, the point is to be replayed. (Remember 60 minute time limit so captains must keep things going quickly.)
7. League Standings: Total win/loses
8. Equipment shall be provided by the league. You may bring your own ball for warm-ups

and also use it in the game with the other teams approval.

9. Each team shall submit a completed roster to Bruce or the bar tender before game time on the date of the first game. The use of ineligible players will result in the forfeiture of that evenings match. A player can not play for more than 1 team per night, per league.

10. Service will be determined for the first game by volley and alternate each game thereafter.

11. If the ball is hit more than twice on your side of the net a girl must hit the ball, in any order, before it goes back over.

12. Everyone on your team must rotate into the game; men for men and women for women. Rotation shall take place before each serve.

13. The server must stand behind the rear boundary line and within 10 feet of the right boundary line. Rotation does not occur until the first server from each team completes their first serve.

14. Each member of the team shall serve in turn, and shall continue to serve until side-out is declared. Serving out of order causes a side out and loss of points during the serve.

15. Simultaneous contact occurs when two or more players contact the ball at the same time. The ball is considered in play and either player involved may hit it again.

16. Touching the net with any part of the body while the ball is in play is considered a foul unless the ball is driven into the net by the opponent causing the contact.

17. If fouls are committed by players on opposing teams simultaneously, the ball shall be

replayed.

A & B LEAGUE

1. Players will not be allowed to hit the ball with a open hand below the waist. (this will be considered a carry.)
2. All serves must be bumped. And if hit above the waist hands must be locked.
3. Touching the net with any part of the body on a spike or block will be strictly called as a net foul.
4. Returning a serve with an open hand above the waist will be considered a carry.
5. If a player returning a serve, hits the ball with their arms and then any other part of their body (chest, shoulder, head, etc..), it shall not be considered a double hit.
6. A player may hit a shot that they have had blocked by an opponent without being called for a double hit.
7. Year End Awards

The regular season champion will receive 1 trophy and tee shirts.
The play off champion will receive 1 trophy.

HOUSE RULES

- 1 Each Night/ League will be in charge of nominating the captain for the team. Any disputes will be handled by the captains of the teams. If the dispute cannot be resolved a meeting of all captains will have to be called.
- 2 It is the captains responsibility to record the results with the sheets provided at the bar.

5. If a player returning a serve, hits the ball with their arms and then any other part of their body (chest, shoulder, head, etc..), it shall not be considered a double hit.

6. A player may hit a shot that they have had blocked by an opponent without being called for a double hit.

7. Year End Awards

The regular season champion will receive 1 trophy and tee shirts.
The play off champion will receive 1 trophy.

15. Simultaneous contact occurs when two or more players contact the ball at the same time. The ball is considered in play and either player involved may hit it again.

16. Touching the net with any part of the body while the ball is in play is considered a foul unless the ball is driven into the net by the opponent causing the contact.

17. If fouls are committed by players on opposing teams simultaneously, the ball shall be

replayed.

13. The server must stand behind the rear boundary line and within 10 feet of the right boundary line. Rotation does not occur until the first server from each team completes their first serve.

14. Each member of the team shall serve in turn, and shall continue to serve until side-out is declared. Serving out of order causes a side out and loss of points during the serve.

15. Simultaneous contact occurs when two or more players contact the ball at the same time. The ball is considered in play and either player involved may hit it again.

16. Touching the net with any part of the body while the ball is in play is considered a foul unless the ball is driven into the net by the opponent causing the contact.

17. If fouls are committed by players on opposing teams simultaneously, the ball shall be replayed.

18. Teams MUST be ready to play within 15 minutes of start time or the late team will forfeit the first game. (2006)

But, a set is OK. (2006)

5. If a player returning a serve, hits the ball with their arms and then any other part of their body (chest, shoulder, head, etc..), it shall not be considered a double hit.

6. A player may hit a shot that they have had blocked by an opponent without being called for a double hit.

7. No blocking of the serve. (2006)

8. Year End Awards

The regular season champion will receive 1 trophy and tee shirts.

The play off champion will receive 1 trophy.
